## Level Of Scrambling



**General Description:** The hike will take us thru an open meadow with rolling hills flanking both sides. The passage way narrows after one mile and funnels into an arroyo that eventually leads to the waterfall in Bar Canyon. With the recent rains it is almost a certainty that water will be flowing. We will break at the waterfall and relax under a small grove of maple trees before we head out into the meadow and traverse the opposite side as we make our way pass the stone house and back to the cars.

**Points of Interest:** An old stone house makes for great photo ops. A beautiful waterfall and grove of maples await us in the canyon and the towering canyon walls offer a majestic sight.

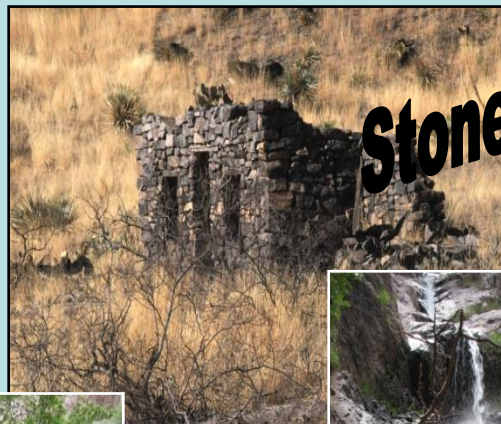
**Level:** Easy with little scrambling at a comfortable pace. All hikers are welcome.

**Length:** 3 1/2 miles & 3 hours including several breaks.

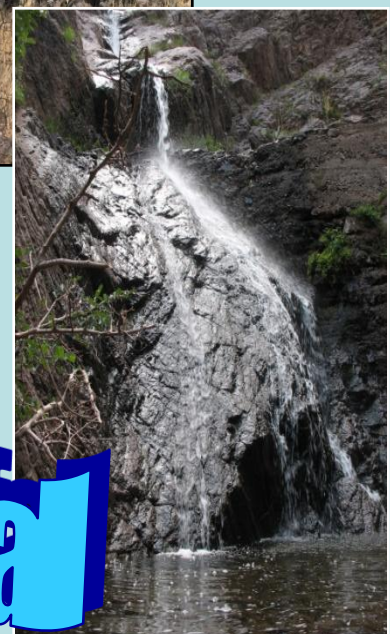
**Elevation:** The total climb is approximately 650ft. from the starting point and mostly very gradual.
